

## Wire Transfers

Wire Transfer requests should be made in person. We will need the following information to complete your request:

- Name, address, home and work phone numbers for person sending the wire
- Sending Account Number and dollar amount of wire
- Name of Receiving Financial Institution, street address, area code and phone number, ABA Routing Number (9 digits for domestic wires)
- Name, address and account number for account/person receiving the wire
- Name, address and account number for further credit instructions (if applicable)

Mainstreet's Wire Transfer cut-off time is 3:00 PM CST for requests \$5,000.00 and more. Cut-off time is 4:30 PM CST for wires under \$5,000.00. All wire requests received after the cut-off time will be held until the next business day.

The cut-off time for foreign wires is 2:00 PM CST. Also, foreign wires may take in excess of one week to reach its final destination.
